Feedback from Audition

- 1. Thank you to all that helped with auditions. Michael stated could use more help to make the event run efficiently?
- 2. Judges need to bring music and know the part they are judging.

- 3. 4 rooms worked really well-shorter day for all and easier for teachers with Junior High students.
- 4. Students were running the recorders this year. However, Michael felt that adults should be pushing the play button on the recorders in future auditions.
- 5. Most districts require teachers to participate in auditions.
- 6. There is still a concern when changing voice parts after students have originally been entered in the system.
- 7. Suggestions of using scan code to scan for High School QR codes-scanners and technology.
- 8. Concern that the audition material was extremely difficult this year.
- 9. Teachers would like the music list earlier if possible.
- 10.Michael would like to send out a survey to figure out why more schools are not auditioning. (need approval from board.)
- 11.It was suggested that at the summer board meeting looking at possibly using different material along with state for district auditions.
- 12. John Taylor suggested contact state choir chairs to discuss problems and suggestions with audition.
